It is important to always know where the emergency exits are and to remember to be calm during a fire emergency.

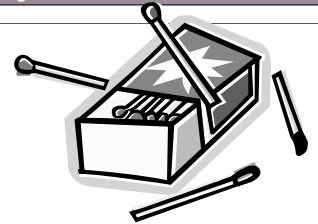
Remember to use the stairs (NEVER use an elevator) to leave the building or fire area right away, then call

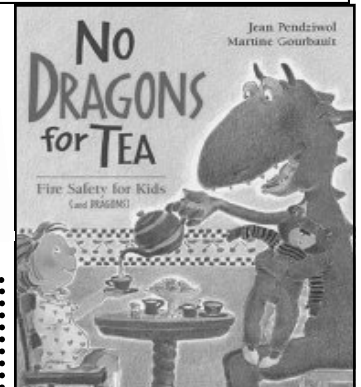
