Application for Burn Barrel Permit for Jefferson County, 2009

Material to be burned: Slash Only...tree branches, leaves, pine needles; NO Trash, Construction Material or Tires.

Barrel will be metal type and washed/cleaned before use. Burn Barrel needs to be in place for site inspection.

II. Burn Barrel Regulations: Burn Barrel Permit is valid from Jan 1 to Dec 31 with burning times from 6 am to 6 pm. Call Jefferson County Sheriff (303-277-0211) and notify Fire Dispatch before you start and when you finish. If you do not call before you burn and Foothills Fire & Rescue is sent on a smoke check due to you burning, you will receive one warning. A second response to your property will result in a ticket from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Dept. Burning during burn bans or high winds, or without calling Jefferson County Fire Dispatch first, will result in a ticket from Jefferson County Sheriff's Dept. Burn Barrel size: 50-55 gallon metal barrel standing upright. Branches will not stick out higher than the top of the barrel; the barrel will not be within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material. When burning, the barrel will not be left unattended. You are required to have a garden hose/water source near the burn barrel. If winds are at or above 15 mph, no burning will be allowed. If winds pick-up after you start burning, you are required to put out your slash burn. Keep the smoke to a minimum, otherwise you will be required to stop burning. Any violations will result in a ticket or permit being revoked. ONLY one burn barrel per residential property. This permit is not for commercial usage or residential properties with wood cutting/firewood businesses per Jefferson County Department of Health and Environment. By signing this application, you have authorized Foothills Fire & Rescue to inspect your burn barrel area at any time you are burning. Although all specified precautions are taken, there is the possibility that the controlled fire could escape your control. By signing this application, you assume the following costs/liabilities:

1. You assume liability for all damages incurred to any other person or property caused by or related to the activities for which the permit is issued.
2. You assume all cost of fire suppression should any open fire escape your control or your failure to follow the regulations listed above and we have to respond and put out the slash pile burn. These costs may include any legal fees incurred by Foothills Fire & Rescue in any civil or criminal action, whether in a court of law or otherwise, which arises from the activities for which this Burn Barrel Permit is issued. You are

required by Jefferson County Department of Health and Environment to include a map to the burn site plus any gate codes to get into your property.

III. AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE: All applications must contain an authorized signature from the Fire Department of jurisdiction. **NOTE: This Form is an Application NOT the Permit.** This document may **NOT** be faxed or mailed to Foothills Fire & Rescue. **You MUST bring it in to our Administrative Office for approval.** Administrative Office located at 67 South Lookout Mountain Road, Golden CO 80401.
