RESOLUTION NO. 2026-09-08-002**

**A RESOLUTION TO ABANDON THE CODE REQUIREMENTS OF THE
INTERNATIONAL WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE [2021 EDITION]**

WHEREAS, the Foothills Fire Protection District ("District") provides fire protection services to a part of the unincorporated limits of the County of Jefferson, State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Section 24-33.5-1237, C.R.S. requires municipalities, fire protection districts, certain metropolitan districts, and counties to adopt a Wildfire Resiliency Code ("Code") that meets or exceeds the standards of the model Code adopted by the Colorado Wildfire Resiliency Code Board; and,

WHEREAS, Jefferson County has adopted a Wildfire Resiliency Code ("WRC") that meets the requirements of C.R.S. § 24-33.5-1237; and,

WHEREAS, the District Board of Directors ("Board") in 2021 had previously adopted the International Wildland Urban Interface Code [2018 Edition] ("IWUIC") with amendments by resolution: and,

WHEREAS, the District has determined that the IWUIC and the Jefferson County Wildfire Resiliency Code have overlap and differences in requirements; and,

WHEREAS, the Board desires to provide uniformity of requirements within the District, and to clarify relations between this District and neighboring Districts.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE FOOTHILLS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT:**

1. **Foothills Fire Protection District Abandons Implementation of the IWUIC**
Pursuant to its authority to adopt, and thus its ability to abandon Code adoptions, the District formally abandons its adoption by resolution of the International Wildland Urban Interface Code [2018]
2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
